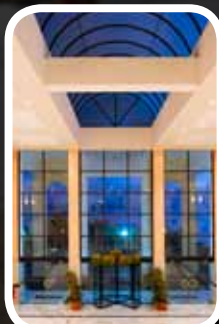
The EC Malta Junior Classic Club programme is set at the beautiful 4 Star Coastline Hotel in the northern coast of Malta commanding fantastic sea and country views. Parents and guardians will have peace of mind knowing that their children are being properly looked after in a comfortable, safe and secure environment. Please note the Coastline is available during the dates listed below - during other periods alternative 4 star hotels will be utilised.

What students should expect from their residence:

- Quad Rooms - students are placed in quad rooms with other students of the same gender but different nationality, unless they request to stay with a friend in advance
- Ensuite Bathroom
- Full board accommodation
- Average journey to school: 20 minutes by EC bus
- Bed linen and towels are provided. Students should bring their own beach towels.
- Rooms and communal areas are cleaned every other day
- For added security and assistance, live-in EC supervisors will stay at the hotel
- Student rooms include: desk / table, lamp, storage space, TV and air-conditioning
- International leaders are accommodated in triple/twin rooms shared with other international leaders. If international leaders book a single room, a supplement will be charged at the time of booking and the room will be reserved based on availability.

EC must be advised upon booking of any medical conditions, allergies or medication that needs to be administered to students. If the students' flights arrive after 22:00 please ensure that the airport transfer information is received by EC at least 2 days prior to arrival to ensure that rooms are available upon arrival. In the case of a late night arrival an extra night fee will be charged. If a late check out is required, this may incur an additional charge.

EC leaders will try and organise luggage storage and shower facilities for late check outs. Any additional charges incurred after arrival have to be paid directly by the student. Please note that a €50 damage deposit will be requested by the hotel during check in. This will be returned upon student departure unless any damages have been made.





Learning

Learning Centres

Spring & Autumn Programmes: Students attend lessons at a learning centre in St Julians.

Summer Programme: Students attend lessons at St. Martin's College (with the exception of the first weeks of the programme when students may attend a school in St Julian's). St Martin's College provide a safe and comfortable environment which is highly conducive to English language learning.

- Students will learn in a fully air-conditioned centre
- Each centre has a dedicated EC Academic Co-ordinator.
- Students are transported to school and activities by a private EC bus service, average journey to school: 10 - 30 minutes.

Course

Students attending this programme will attend a General English course.

- General English – 20 morning / afternoon lessons (45 mins each) per week for a total of 15 hours. The course will help improve English language skills by focusing on the key areas: reading, writing, speaking and listening. A strong focus is placed on speech and using the language confidently and fluently.
- On the first day, all students sit a placement test - The placement test assesses students in listening, reading, writing and use of English allowing academic staff to place students in the relevant group for their ability.
- Students study in classes of a maximum of 15 students
- Our dedicated and professional teaching staff provide feedback and support and help students build confidence to speak English.
- International classes.

Attendance

Attendance to class is compulsory unless there is a justified reason for absence. In case of a student falling ill, an EC staff member will provide assistance. European students travelling with a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) are entitled to free public healthcare. Students requesting private medical treatment must be prepared to pay approximately €25 to see a doctor; this must be paid at the time of their visit.

After School

Meals

Students are entitled to meals as follows:

Spring & Autumn: Breakfast, packed lunch & dinner.

Summer: Breakfast, a combination of hot and packed lunches & dinner. Upon arrival, social leaders will advise when meals are served. Meals normally consist of:

Continental breakfast: Tea, coffee, milk & fruit juice / choice of fresh bread, butter, jam & marmalade / ham & cheeses / yogurt / choice of cereals.

Packed lunch: A large sandwich, fruit, a bar of chocolate and a 500ml bottle of water. During the week packed lunches are collected at school, on the weekend packed lunches are collected from the accommodation.

Hot Lunch: Every other day at school. Lunches include a hot snack coupled with a salad (pasta / rice / vegetables) and a dessert such as fruit or an item of confectionery.

Evening meal: 3-course buffet meal with a choice of starters including salads, a pasta dish and a soup choice. Main course with three choices including meat, chicken, fish, a selection of vegetables and dessert consisting of fruit salad and ice cream.

Note: EC must be informed at the time of booking of any other special dietary requirements.

Activities

A full varied activity programme is included.

A private EC bus service takes students to and from activities.

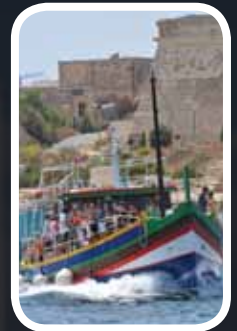


Extra Activities

Welfare, Rules and Disciplinary Action

Customer Complaints

At EC, we endeavour to provide our students with the highest possible level of service. If, however, a student is unsatisfied with any aspect of their programme with EC, we ask that they inform us immediately. Most problems are small and can be quickly resolved by our staff members. During the first week of school, all students are given an Initial Course Evaluation form, in which they are asked to evaluate various aspects of their stay, such as tuition, accommodation and leisure. The form also allows students the opportunity to bring to our attention anything that is not to their satisfaction should they feel unable to speak to us directly. Solutions to any issues will be provided and all necessary parties will be notified when applicable. Students are also requested to complete an End of Course Evaluation form at the end of their stay such that they have the opportunity to provide EC with general feedback before returning to their home country.

Accommodation Rules

- Students must keep their room neat and tidy.
- Curfew times must be respected by all students.
- Students who are not living at the hotel are not allowed to stay in any of the rooms or use any of the hotel's facilities or restaurants.
- Girls are not allowed to stay in the boys' rooms and vice versa.
- EC must be advised well in advance (upon booking) of any medical conditions, allergies or medication that need to be administered to students.
- Students are liable for any damages/breakages caused to school/hotel property. Payment for damages must be effected immediately.
- The hotel may have specific regulations that will be communicated upon the students arrival.

Course Certificate

Students must attend all lessons and organised activities in order to receive their End of Course Certificate

Alcohol Consumption

The consumption of alcohol by Junior students is not allowed. Students who consume alcohol risk being expelled from EC and repatriated to their home country at their own expense.

Drugs

The consumption and/or possession of any illegal drugs will result in the immediate expulsion and repatriation of the student at their own expense. The intervention of the police may also be necessary in such an event.

Smoking

The legal age for smoking in Malta is 16 years.

Expulsion

EC reserves the right to expel and repatriate a student at his/her own expense for any of the reasons including but not limited to the circumstances listed below:

- Possession and/or use of any illegal drugs
- Consumption of alcohol
- Malicious damage to school property and/or place of accommodation
- Being a danger to his/her own safety or that of other students
- Breaking Maltese law
- Repeated failure to attend academic lessons

In any of the above circumstances the student will be informed that their stay is going to be terminated with immediate effect. Simultaneously EC will inform the student's agent about the student's behaviour and the course of action to be taken. The earliest flight available will be booked and an EC staff member will accompany the student to the airport to ensure that the student leaves the country safely. Following such action EC will terminate all relationships with the student and will be unable to take further responsibility for the student. No refunds will be given to any student who has been expelled.
