The campus is 30 minutes from the heart of downtown Vancouver, host of the 2010 Winter Olympics.


UBC at Vancouver is the ideal setting for students to experience the beautiful Northwest scenery and history.

### A TYPICAL DAY WITH ARDMORE

Students have three hours of English lessons per day from Monday to Friday. Lessons are divided into two parts:
