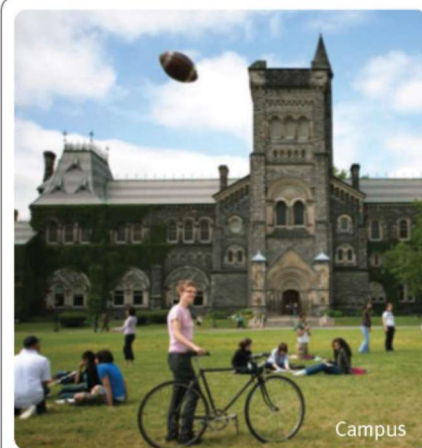

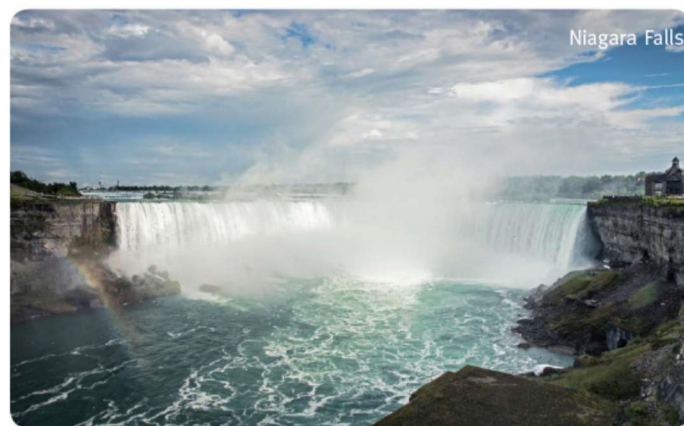

Part One: Language input which involves using grammar and vocabulary in various tasks/exercises.

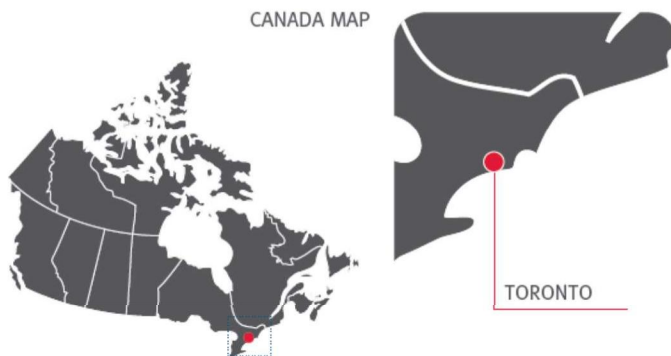
Part Two: Fluency/practise activities aimed at developing fluency through specific tasks like designing a website or poster, conducting a classroom survey or even producing/acting in a short play.
