



Homestay

Staying in an English host home is a great way to discover the English way of life and practise your English language.

Address

Varied locations less than 45 minutes from school: Twickenham, Whitton, Teddington, Richmond, Hounslow, Brentford, St Margarets, Isleworth, Feltham, Hampton, Hanworth and other surrounding areas.

Type of accommodation

Homestay, arranged by a partner accommodation agency.

Age of students

16 years and over. Younger students by arrangement.

Check-in and check-out

Check-in on Sundays 09.00-23.00. Check-out Saturdays 08.00 - 11.00.

Meals

Breakfast, half board and occasionally full board available.

Kitchen/cooking facilities

Students are not normally expected to use the kitchen. Students can use facilities for hot drinks.

Rooms

Single or shared rooms available. Each room also has a bed, desk and storage facilities. Shared accommodation is only offered when two people book together.

Bathrooms

Rooms may have private or shared bathrooms. Facilities will vary, but students always have access to a shower, basin and WC.

Utilities

Electricity, heating and lighting are included in the price. Electricity is 230V, 50Hz AC.

Internet and phone

Some, but not all, hosts offer internet access. Use of telephones is by arrangement.

Laundry

Hosts will wash bed linen, towels and a reasonable amount of the student's personal items. Public laundrettes are also available. Students must bring enough clean clothes for the first week.

Security and keys

Keys to the house are issued to students aged 18 and older on arrival, but bedrooms do not normally have locks.

Bed linen, towels and cleaning

Bed linen provided by the host. Towels are not provided. The rooms will be cleaned by the host.

Deposit & Damage Charges

No deposit is required. Damage at cost.

Visitors

Visitors are allowed at each host's discretion.

Noise and restrictions

Students should discuss any house rules or restrictions with their host. 16 and 17 year olds will be required to comply with a curfew.

Availability

Available all year to students aged 16 and older.

Holding rooms

A fee will be charged to store luggage or keep possessions in a room if students take holidays away from the school.

Usually less than 45 minutes on foot or by local transport from LAL London.
